Clerk's Notes July 2024

- 1. Highways have been asked to take back responsibility for cutting the grass outside Carters, as volunteers are no longer taking responsibility (email received from Marj Crone-Smith)
- 2. Lamp next to Forge Cottage reported for adjustment, as it shines all night and keeps residents awake.
- 3. Clare James has agreed to put up a warning notice about pedestrians at the end of the Bicton Park lane that runs past the mausoleum straight to the main road.
- 4. A Reliant car has been parked in Brookfield Road for over four months. A concerned neighbour asked me to report it. I checked on the DVLA site and as it has no MOT, I have reported it to EDDC.
- 5. Bagwells' electrician spent three hours inspecting the flushing mechanism at the Public Toilets and discussing it with their expert back at base. He recommends the fitting of a new sensor and attachment to the water system -cost £368.25 net.
- 6. The Recreation Ground has been transferred by CDE to Venn Bridger LLP, part of the Clinton Devon Estates group. I have asked for a copy of the legal agreement to keep with our Lease.
- 7. Correspondence has been received from Maria Kowalski on behalf of the Heritage Museum. They may be interested in acquiring the toilet block as a Heritage Centre, as Salem Chapel will probably become unavailable in 9 months time. However, there is no way they could pay the tentative sale value of £50,000.00
